Scavenger hunts, exploration games, interactive discussions and hands on samples keep children engaged with the artwork in the gallery.

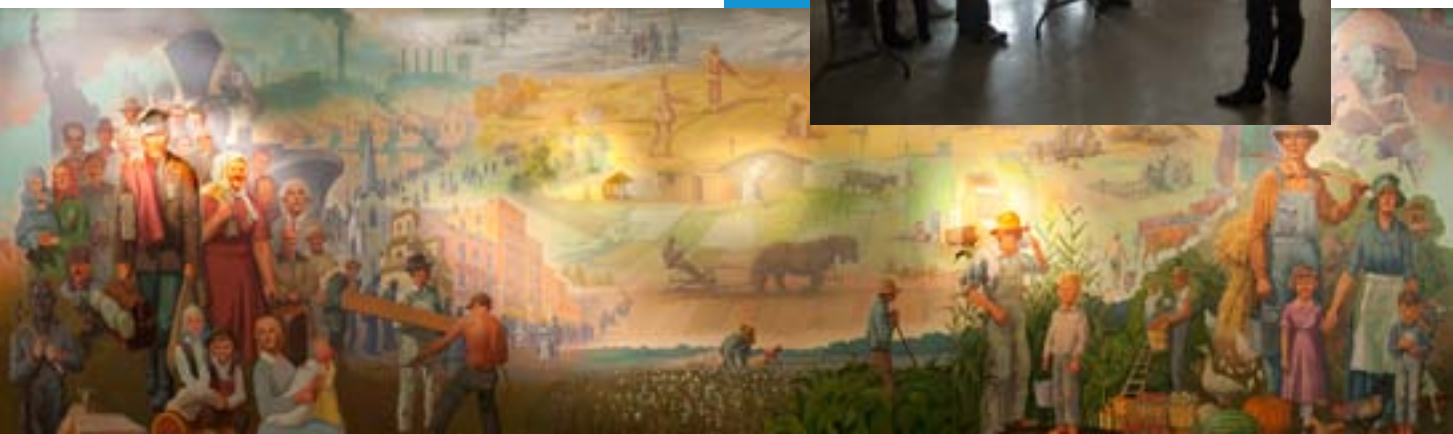
Your group will be led through a current art exhibit. Tour themes vary with rotating exhibits and can be catered to match specific classroom subjects.

The Dahl Arts Center houses the unique Cyclorama Mural which features a 180-foot oil-on-canvas panorama spanning 200 years of U.S. economic history. Enhanced by special lighting and narration, this extraordinary art work was designed and painted by acclaimed muralist Bernard P. Thomas.
