Here is what you need to know:

- We are limiting the amount of people in the Education Department at any given time during classes, camps, and gallery viewing. No more than 10 individuals will be allowed to visit the Cultural Café and Gallery at one time to allow for proper social distancing practices. If the gallery is full, you can either wait to be let in, or come back at a later time.
- Everyone who visits us at the Dahl is **required to wear a mask.**
- Upon entering, we ask that you use the provided hand sanitizer.
- Social distancing practices of keeping at least 6 ft. apart from others (unless within your small group) still apply.

If you come in and we see that you are having any sort of symptoms mentioned above, we will kindly ask you to leave.
