

Crazy Horse Memorial - CONTINUING EDUCATION GRANT

Overview

The Continuing Education Grants are designed to provide financial support to Native artists committed to improving artistic skill and their careers as artists. This grant provides funds to support artists by providing funding to attend workshops, classes and/or conferences, or for marketing their existing works to reach new geographic or social audiences. Other related ideas and purposes are welcomed.

Eligibility

- o Individual Native artist, who is an enrolled member of a federally recognized American Indian tribe from these four states; Minnesota, North Dakota, South Dakota or Wisconsin (a list can be found on the application form)
- o Currently creating art in any discipline
- o Committed to advancing his/her professional career

Selection

Completed applications submitted by Native artists will be reviewed by INDIAN MUSEUM OF NORTH AMERICA® professionals who administer the program. Applicants will be rated based on meeting eligibility requirements and the content of completed applications and the goals of the grant program. The grant is designed to assist artists in the development of their professional careers in the arts.

A completed application consists of the following:

- Completed application form
- Certificate of Degree of Indian Blood
- 3-5 images of current artworks
- One page essay (no more than 300 words) stating:
 - o The type of continuing education opportunity you are applying for ie: class, conference, workshop or marketing
 - o Description of how this opportunity might help you in your career goals
 - o Simple budget outlining how grant will be expended
- If application is accepted applicants will be required to write a report stating:
 - o How the grant has helped you in your career (Due one month after opportunity)

Funding

Applicants may request up to \$1,500 for Continuing Education Grants. Use of funds include, but are not limited to: travel costs, conference and/or class fees.

Deadline

Grants are received on a continuous basis and between 12- 15 grants are awarded per year on a first come first serve basis.
