

**JOHN AND PEGGY LANGENFELD MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP
2018 Application
Rapid City Arts Council**

This scholarship is for the continued education of gifted local area high school DANCE or MUSIC students. The John and Peggy Langenfeld Memorial Scholarship will be awarded to one Rapid City student in the amount of \$500.

The student must be a high school student attending a Rapid City school (Rapid City Stevens, Douglas, Rapid City Central, Rapid City Christian or St. Thomas More High School). Funds may be used for:

- Private lessons with advanced level instructor, advanced training opportunities, auditions support (travel), or college/university tuition, room and board.
- Scholarship is based on **talent and need**. People providing recommendations should comment on the student's talent, financial need (if known) and achievements.
- Scholarship check will be made payable to the student prior to the opening date of the advanced training or college session after proof of admission or registration has been provided.
- The recipient agrees to provide a digital photo and short bio which will be made available to local media and provide a thank you letter to be shared with the Langenfeld family and Rapid City Arts Council board of directors.
- Applications must be postmarked or emailed on or before **May 7, 2018**. Winner will be notified May 18, 2018. Applicants may download application online at www.thedahl.org.

To apply:

- (1) Fill out application information below.
- (2) Ask two adults (i.e. teacher, mentor, boss - adults who are not a guardian or family member) who are familiar with your talent and need to provide recommendations for you. (see attached form). Recommendations should be filled out and put into a sealed envelope for you to return with the application if it is mailed, or information emailed **directly** from the person recommending to the Rapid City Arts Council if submitted electronically (tyler@thedahl.org).
- (3) Send application and recommendation forms to the address below postmarked on or before **May 7, 2018**. Or you may scan the forms or duplicate info in an email and send electronically to tyler@thedahl.org by May 7, 2018.
